

JAMES MALLORY Class of 2005



Mallory is one of the most prolific football players ever to grace Crosby Field. The three-sport athlete owns every major rushing record for the Blue Devil football program and his skills led him to a storied Division 1 collegiate career.

The powerfully built running back rushed for 4,531 yards in his career, nearly doubling the previous career mark. He holds the two most productive single seasons for rushing eclipsing the legendary 2,000 mark in 2004. Mallory holds the Top Four places in most yards in a single game, highlighted by his 385 yards in 2003. Mallory scored 55 touchdowns in his career which is also a school record. James was named All Division, All WNY and to an All-State team in high school.

The talented basketball player and track athlete as a Blue Devil took his football skills to Central Connecticut State University and left as a two-time All-American, 2nd in career rushing with 3,245 yards and as Conference Offensive Player of the

Year and Most Valuable Player. His teams captured two conference titles. He was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award and was ranked as the 13th best back coming out of college in 2010.

Mallory was signed as a rookie Free Agent by the Tampa Bay Bucs. He played professionally in the Arena League for Lehigh Valley. He currently plays for the South Buffalo Celtics who have ties organizationally to the Toronto Argonauts of the CFL.
