Susan Falsone is being inducted in the Honorary category for her contributions to athletics. Falsone currently serves as the Los Angeles Dodgers head athletic trainer, her second year in the position. She is the first and only female head trainer in any of the four major professional sports. Originally she was hired by the Dodgers as an assistant athletic trainer in 2007.

The 1992 Blue Devil graduate ran track and played soccer in her years at Ken West, but it is in her barrier-breaking role in professional sports that

has garnered her attention and accolades. Prior to being hired by the Dodgers, Falsone worked at Athletes' Performance, an elite training facility in Phoenix.

Sue was drawn early to orthopedic medicine, physical therapy and athletics. She earned her bachelor's degree in Physical Therapy from Daemen College and a master's in Human Movement Science with a concentration in Sports Medicine at the University of North Carolina.
