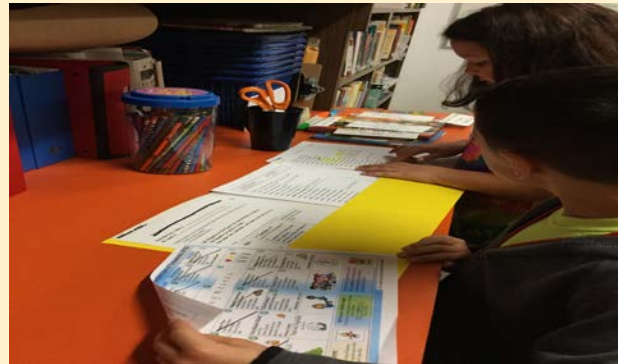
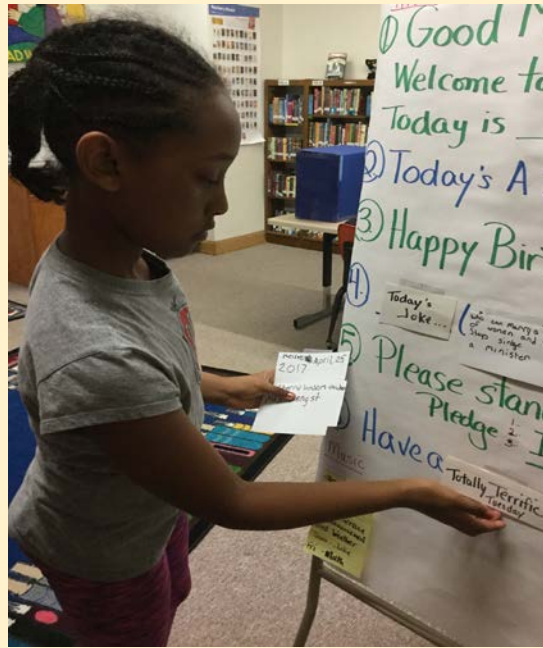

Digital Announcements at Station EES

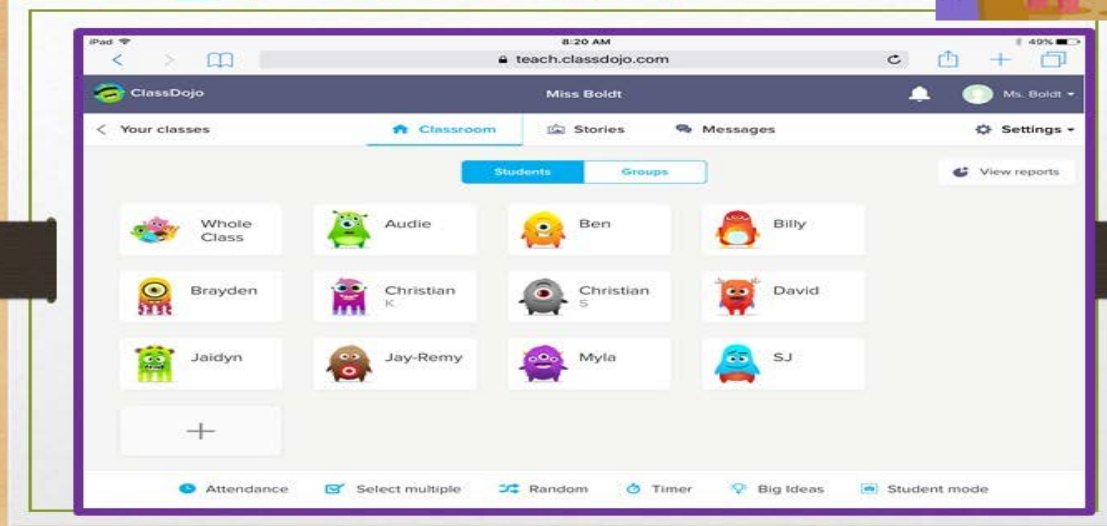
Each morning at Edison Elementary School, three 4th grade students hurry to the library to check any updates for the daily news.

Google Classroom



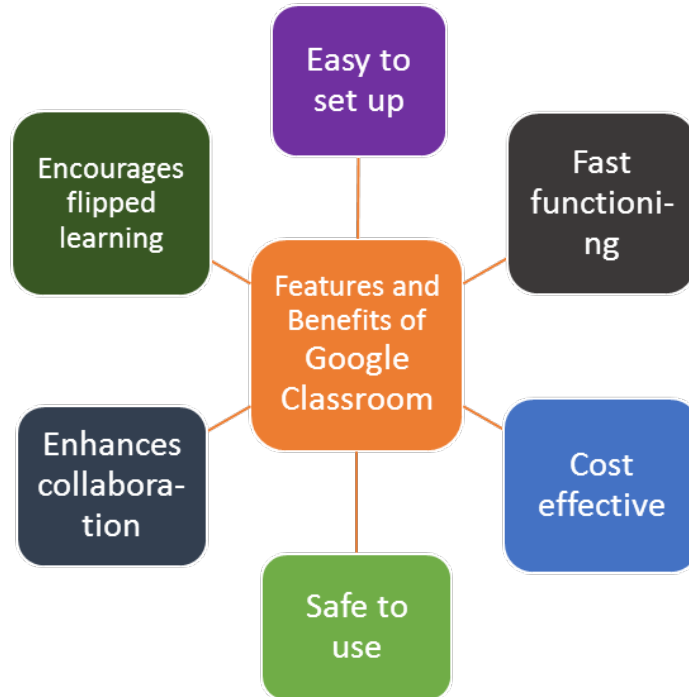
- Everyday the teacher can add assignments and information. Teachers can include video, worksheets, assignments and exemplars.

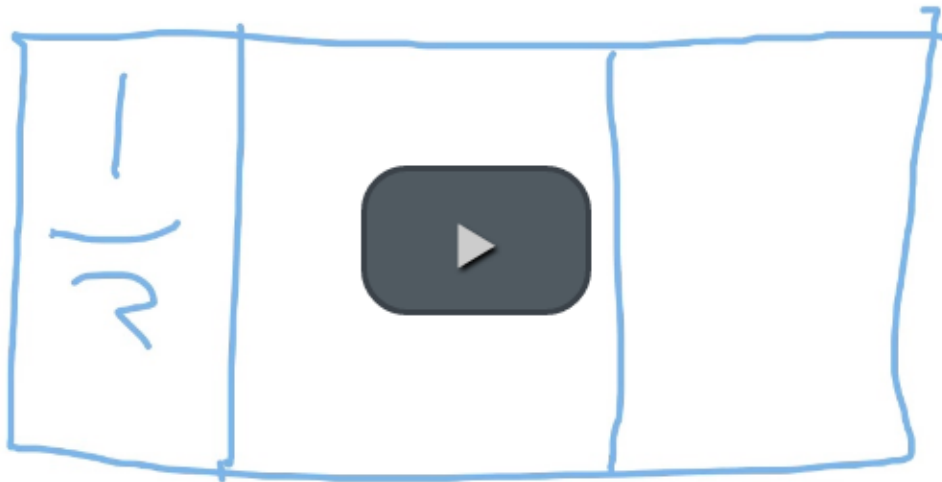
