A meeting of the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District, Erie County, New York (the "District") was convened in public session at ______ in the District, on February 14, 2017 at _____ p.m., local time.

RESOLUTION OF THE KENMORE-TOWN OF TONAWANDA UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT, ERIE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE **"DISTRICT"**) CONFIRMING THE **DISTRICT'S** CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT INVOLVING THE REPLACEMENT OF EXTERIOR WINDOWS AT THE DISTRICT'S CHARLES A. LINDBERGH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO BE A TYPE II ACTION **UNDER** SEORA. AND CONFIRMING SUCH WORK AS CONSTITUTING A "CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT" UNDER THE DISTRICT'S APPROVED 2016-2017 ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District, Erie County, New York (the "District"), after consultation by District officials with the District's retained architectural firm (SEI Design Group), has determined to undertake, during the District's current (2016-2017) fiscal year, a modest capital outlay project involving the removal and in-kind replacement of exterior windows at the District's Charles A. Lindbergh Elementary School (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated maximum cost of the Project, including all incidental costs relating thereto, has been determined by SEI Design Group to be \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the District have approved the District's 2016-2017 budget that provided for a \$100,000 transfer to capital to fund the Project, with the work on the Project to occur during the District's 2016-2017 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Section 617.5 of the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617) provides that certain activities are Type II actions which are not subject to review under SEQRA, and that such activities include routine activities of educational institutions; maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility; and replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site; and

WHEREAS, the Project constitutes such routine activities of educational institutions; maintenance or repair activities; and/or in-kind, same-site replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction activities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District's Board of Education hereby confirms and formalizes its prior determination that the Project is a Type II action, which is not subject to review under SEQRA, and that the Project will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Project shall continue to be funded by means of a "transfer to capital" (not exceeding \$100,000 in amount) in the District's approved budget for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, so that the Project can be undertaken and completed, as planned, in the District's 2016-2017 fiscal year; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
