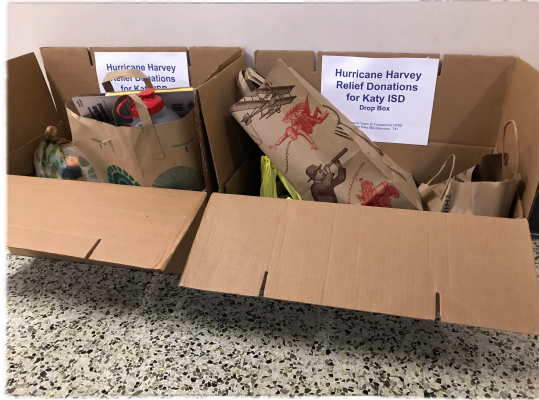
The Big Picture students were able to see what a caring community we have in Ken-Ton!
