Section 4.6.2 (A) of the KTA contract states the following: "Each tenured Teacher's instructional skills shall be assessed annually utilizing a three-year cycle. One year of the cycle must include involvement of an Administrator in a formal assessment. Each year of the three-year cycle the Teacher may be required to take ten (10) hours per year of prescribed coursework. The Administrator may suggest additional coursework that would benefit the professional growth of the Teacher, or may waive the requirement of ten (10) hours for the next year's cycle based on the Teacher's assessment and previous professional development coursework."
