

FMS jazz band: Jazz band will meet once a week after school. (exact date and time TBA) The objective is to expose students to the idiom of jazz music and its practices and to teach them basic jazz style and improvisation. Participation in jazz band is by audition.

Digital Storytelling Club: (TBA) In the club, we will use a variety of apps including movie making programs, text-based apps, and other multimodal apps to compose, produce, and share our stories. Students may use their own devices or we will have the option of using computers in school.

Socrates Club will meet the first Wednesday of each month, starting next week. This is a philosophical discussion club and you the students pick the topics. If interested, please write a 2 sentence summary about why you want to be in the club and also write at least 2 discussion topics of interest to you. I need this information by THIS FRIDAY. This club meets from 3:11-4 pm in Mrs. Otto's room 283. This club will be limited to seventh grade students only.

The Recycling and Sustainable Earth Solutions Club is open for students to participate in most Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students can plug in whenever they have time. Our schedule is flexible because the kids will decide which of these days work best for them. They could choose to recycle each Tuesday and then use Wednesdays and Thursdays for goal setting or planning for and hosting events...etc. Students may choose to attend all 3 days or any one or two or even skip a week if their schedule is too full with homework or sports or other clubs. It's an open door concept so the students can manage their time and juggle their interests.

The Yearbook Club is even more flexible. While students can stay after school to photograph sporting events, dances and community service nights...etc., we also need them to take pictures during the school day to chronicle classroom celebrations, projects music performances and more. Students will be building skills including editing and layout of photos and yearbook pages. They will attend on club an as needed basis, determined by publication goals coinciding with a variety of events on the calendar.

Student Leadership Council: Will meet biweekly on the second and fourth Thursday each month after school. The focus of the club is to develop and strengthen the leadership skills of interested students. In addition, participating students will help plan and promote School Spirit Weeks as well as other fun and festive school events.

The Franklin Middle School Running Club focuses on improving running skills through group runs and positive team-building exercises. Runners will learn basic running techniques and progressively increase their distance over this six to seven week program. Running Club will generally be held two to three days a week from 3:15-4:15. We will meet at 3:15 outside the FMS gym.
